D. A Household Card provides summer-long access for any one family visitor, when accompanied by the resident. Only one of these cards will be issued per household. Additional guests can pay \$5 cash per visit or use the owner's Guest Pass Card (see E. below). Facilities Fee of \$160 must be paid to purchase a Household Card.

E. Guest Pass Card (Punch Card) provides for up to twenty guest visits, cost - \$60 each card. These are only valid when presented by the resident. Facilities Fee of \$160 must be paid in order to purchase a Guest Pass Card. Guest Pass Cards may be carried over from year to year.

F. Renter Fees – **See reverse side.** Owners planning to rent their property must first pay the \$160 Facilities Fee.

Summer Renters

- Renters may not use Owner's cards.
- Landlords pay \$200 per week or, if applicable, \$1,000 for full season rental to a single family. These payments provide for up to 6 rental passes and are due by June 15, 2011.
- Landlords who pay after June 15, 2011 must pay \$250/week or \$1,250/season.
- Checks will no longer be accepted from Renters – all checks must be drawn on the Great Harbors property owner's account.
- Renters may pick up cards at the Toll House for each family member (up to six) at the time of occupancy. Each additional card issued (in excess of six) will cost \$25 for a weekly rental or \$125 for a seasonal rental.

Please submit a **Renter Profile Sheet** for each renter with appropriate fees. Renter profiles and checks for rental weeks or seasonal rental **must come from the landlord**, not the renting family.
