GHRA Facility Rules and Regulations

General Rules

1. Facility cards must be turned in at the Tollhouse to gain admission to the tennis courts or the pool area. Replacement cards will be issued for \$5 per card.
2. Members and guests using the pool or clubhouse recreation areas must enter and exit through the tollhouse. Not the front door of the clubhouse or back gate of the pool.
3. Parents are responsible for the behavior of their children at all times. No one is allowed to play on the docks at either Joyce Street or Sally Lane. If a child is found vandalizing boats or docks, the parents will be held financially responsible.
4. Failure to comply with any of the GHRA Facility Rules will result in loss of privileges.
14. Lifeguards and Recreation staff have the final say on all rules and regulations, and in the event of an emergency, must be obeyed immediately without question.

Tiny Tot Wading Pool

1. All children using the wading pool must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
2. No children over the age of 6 are permitted to use the wading pool.
3. Swim diapers or rubber pants must be worn if children are not toilet trained.

Clubhouse Rules

1. Children under the age of 12 are not permitted in the upper level of the clubhouse unless accompanied by an adult.
2. Bathers must dry off before entering the clubhouse.
3. Any problems in the Clubhouse must be reported to the Lifeguards immediately.

Tennis Rules

1. Tennis courts are reserved for residents of Great Harbors, their families and guests.
2. Proper tennis attire is required at all times.
3. No play on court 3 before 9 a.m.
4. Courts may be reserved at the Tollhouse for the current day and the following calendar day only. Reservations are free of charge.

Ballfield

The Great Harbors Ball field was created in the 1970's for resident use. It has a Little League layout and is designed for ages 12 and under, and for softball. Other encouraged uses are soccer, lacrosse, kickball and wiffleball.

1. The field is available to Great Harbors' residents and guests on a first come basis.
2. No balls shall enter the playground area, tennis courts or parking areas. This is a critical safety concern and violators will be banned from further field use.
3. Field users are to clean the area after use, disposing of trash and grading baselines and home plate if applicable.
4. GHRA recreation programs or planned events have priority use of the field.
5. Bicycles, scooters and golf practice are not permitted on the field.

Pool Rules

1. **Lifeguards are responsible for enforcing rules and responding to emergencies. Parents MUST supervise their children.**
2. Showers are required of all swimmers before entering the pools.
3. No one is allowed in the pool with a communicable disease.
4. No glass or sharp objects are allowed in the pool area.
5. No smoking is permitted in the pool area.
6. Due to public health concerns patrons under the age of 3 or who are not fully toilet trained may not enter the main pool.
7. Patrons under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a guardian over the age of 18 while in the pool area.
8. All jumping water entries must be feet-first, facing forward, and from the edge of the pool. **No diving, twisting or getting a running start is allowed.**
9. Running, horseplay or pushing is not permitted in the pool area.
10. The use of toys in the main pool must be approved by the lifeguards on duty.
11. No flotation devices, with the exception of kickboards for laps, are allowed in the pool except during pre-approved recreation events.
12. Swimmers must swim under, not over, the lane lines and boundary ropes.
13. In order to enter the deep end swimmers must complete the deep end test administered by a lifeguard. Swimmers must swim front crawl for one length of the pool and tread water for 30 seconds.

Pool hours are subject to change during the summer.

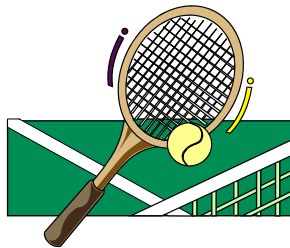
Swim Lessons: Two four-week swim lesson sessions will be offered at a cost of \$50 per child for each session. The instructor will reschedule only those lessons cancelled due to weather. Classes are taught by trained Water Safety Instructors and are approved by the American Red Cross. The sessions will begin on Monday, July 6th and Monday, August 3rd. Payment in full is due at time of registration. There are no refunds for missed classes, nor any prorating of fees.

Swim Team

The Great Harbors Swim Team is designed to enhance stroke technique, foster the spirit of friendly competition, and, to have fun. Kick-boarders to advanced swimmers are welcome.

Kids' Night

Every Wednesday, the pool will be open from 6:30-8:00 p.m. for the enjoyment of the children of Great Harbors. Flotation devices are permitted on Kids' Night.



Tennis Program

Tennis Lessons: One six week session will be offered at a cost of \$150 per child. Little Grippers tennis will be offered for kids ages 5-6 but will only be a ½ hour at a cost of \$75. Tennis lessons will begin on July 6th and will be held on Mondays and Wednesdays. Lessons cancelled due to bad weather will be rescheduled by the instructor. Please check for signs at the Tollhouse.

Tennis Team: The Great Harbors Tennis Team is an opportunity for kids to improve their skills and participate in match play. Competitions will be held with other clubs throughout the summer. Practices are held on Fridays from 10:30am – 12:00pm.

Women's Round Robin: Tuesdays at 7:00pm with a \$5 entry fee.

Doubles Clinic: Mondays at 6:30pm at a cost of \$10 per player.

Cardio Tennis: Thursdays at 5:00pm at a cost of \$10 per player.
