IN THE EVENT OF STORMY WEATHER OR AN EMERGENCY SITUATION THAT WOULD RESULT IN A NEIGHBORHOOD POWER OUTAGE, THE GREAT HARBORS CLUBHOUSE IS AVAILABLE AS A "SAFE HAVEN" AND IS RECOGNIZED AS SUCH BY THE FALMOUTH FIRE DEPARTMENT.

Members should tune into the radio and/or TV for weather updates relating to anticipated stormy weather or any emergency which could result in the loss of power. The clubhouse will be available for such emergencies and will be open for use for our residents on a limited basis. When possible, an email will be sent as a form of notification prior to the emergency and a flag (to be purchased) will be displayed on the clubhouse to indicate that it is available.

Resident's responsibilities:

- ❖ Secure your home
- ❖ Contact a family member before leaving your home and heading to the clubhouse
- ❖ Gather all medication, special food items, cell phones and chargers to bring with you

The clubhouse will be available during the day only, from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. It will be stocked with water, canned soup, cocoa, coffee, tea and asst. crackers.

No pets will be allowed in the clubhouse.

Should the emergency exist beyond 4:00 pm the **Falmouth Certified Emergency Team** will be contacted and residents will be transferred to the local Emergency Shelter for the night.
